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Abstract. Conducting the research on the topic 'Student's Communication in the International Environment.' was about the Erasmus program and students who participated in it, intermediated by the Faculty of Organization and Informatics. The main goal of the research was to identify the attitudes, motives, opinions, and experiences of outgoing and incoming students who participated in the Erasmus program. There were 24 incoming (N=18) and 16 (N=14) outgoing students in the year 2018/2019. Testing the hypotheses have shown that there is a statistically significant disparity between outgoing and incoming students regarding their gender and motives for the Erasmus program. International Relation Offices were included in this research as well, with the results presented below.
